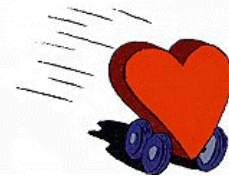

Sunday, SEPTEMBER 15TH:

Sunday, SEPTEMBER 22ND:

Ohio Bicentennial Barn Tour. We will meet at Highbanks Metro Park on Rt. 23 . Registration 12 to 12:45 pm first car leaving at 1:00 pm then every 5 to 10 minutes.
